David Chao asked for clarification regarding .6 FTE appointments. Devan Ganeshananthan responded that the increase in staff is necessary due to increasing student enrollment.

A brief discussion ensued regarding enrollment in sports teams and the challenges that result when programs and coaches are approved without sufficient enrollment. Devan Ganeshananthan said the process is the same as with fluctuating enrollment and added that it is the district's responsibility to fulfill program needs.

Victoria Kniewel commented that data regarding coaches and programs can be shared with the board.

Jonathan Faust asked for clarification regarding the title of JV coaches. Devan Ganeshananthan said that the reason the JV coaches are listed as "Assistant" is due to contract language. Victoria Kniewel commented that language consistency is an area that can be reviewed.
