I. <u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: Mr. Grieco, President, opened the December 19, 2012 Board of Education meeting at approximately 8:06 pm in the WMS/WHS Library. Mr. Grieco dedicated a moment of silence to the family and friends affected by the horrific events at Sandy Hook Elementary School in Newton, Connecticut. Mr. Grieco requested that we keep them in our thoughts and prayers. After the moment of silence, the pledge to the flag was recited.

II. ANNOUNCEMENTS/INFORMATION ITEMS

- □ WHS Student Council: No report.
- WHS PTA: Ms. Marybeth Ederer, President, wished everyone a happy holiday, Merry Christmas and a happy new year. Ms. Ederer reported the membership drive is ongoing; scholarship donation letters will be sent out in January; and Westlake High School clothing is available for purchase. Information regarding the purchase of WHS clothing is on the PTA website. Ms. Ederer also reported the PTA's will contact the Sandy Hook Elementary PTA's. Ms. Ederer acknowledged that the District already was in the process of instituting a security system prior to the tragic events at Sandy Hook Elementary School.
- WHS BLT: Mr. Keith Schenker, Principal, congratulated the students who participated in the holiday concert and art show. Mr. Schenker reported the students are excited to try the block scheduling pilot. The longer block pilot will

- consist of two cycles, eight days, from March 11 March 20, 2013. The students asked many good questions regarding the use of block scheduling. Mr. Schenker reported a conversation has begun on weighted grades and the International Baccalaureate program. Mr. Schenker acknowledged the students are beginning to receive their college acceptances and congratulated them. Mr. Schenker wished everyone a happy and healthy holiday season.
- WMS PTA: No report.
- WMS BLT: Dr. Robert Hendrickson, Principal, reported that the art show and holiday concerts were wonderful and congratulated the students and teachers. Dr. Hendrickson reported on the following: discussions took place on raising the expectations and making connections; the APPR and how teachers are being held accountable; sharing of the 8th grade sample questions that will be on the assessment; a parent coffee hour will probably be held on the topic; additional courses might be offered next year which could include the living environment and possibly having all students take algebra in the 8th grade. This is being driven by the 8th grade common core curriculum. Dr. Hendrickson continued that the conversation needs to continue as it would affect Columbus Elementary School as well as the Westlake High School. Dr. Hendrickson reported other topics discussed included: the current honor roll; posting of grades on the parent portal; the piloting of the electronic grade book and requesting feedback from teachers and parents; the distribution of a survey in January on the topic of what do we want our youngsters to look like, be like, and sound like when they get to the high school. Dr. Hendrickson wished everyone a happy holiday season and happy new year.
- □ Elementary PTA: Rose Cappa Rotunno, President, began her report by offering prayers and her sympathies to those affected by the tragedy of Newton, Connecticut. Ms. Rotunno thanked the Board for making security a priority. The PTA has been very busy with the following: wrapping paper and pie fundraisers; the holiday boutiques; and craft fair. Ms. Rotunno reported that Turkey Bingo was postponed, but there will be a Spring-O-Bingo. Ms. Rotunno thanked all the volunteers for their efforts in making the activities a success. Upcoming events are: family bowling on January 12th and the Father/Daughter Dance on February 2nd. Ms. Rotunno wished everyone a happy and healthy holiday season.
- Columbus BLT: Mr. Michael Cunzio, Principal, thanked Mrs. McCabe for making the items sold at the Holiday Boutique. Mr. Cunzio reported that at the December 4th BLT meeting, the following items were discussed/presented: mathematics and the six instructional shifts in the common core math standards; Ms. Jennifer Rutledge, grades 3-5 math curriculum leader, spoke about the changes in moving to the common core and a workshop is planned for the parents in January/February; encourage the parents to visit "Engage NY" where information is housed on the subject; the budget process and next steps; and encouraging parents to attend the budget workshops/forums. Mr. Cunzio wished everyone happy holidays, Merry Christmas, and a healthy and happy 2013.
- HES BLT: Mr. Schulman, Principal, thanked Mr. Cunzio, Mr. Hood, and the Columbus Troubadours for their outstanding three performances at Hawthorne.
 In addition, Mr. Schulman continued that the kindergarten classes began

identifying math shapes. Mr. Schulman reported the BLT met on December 12, 2012 with the approval of minutes and discussed the following: different ways to spend remaining monies in the \$2,000 Mt. Pleasant Education Foundation Grant as it pertains to the Power Patch Garden; possibly purchasing a composter with the remaining monies from the \$500 Math/Science Exxon/Mobil Grant; Ms. Newman explained bucket filling (good) /bucket dipping(bad) concept used in her classroom and the proposed use of bucket filling/dipping at all grade levels in Hawthorne; and each grade will have their own Celebration of Learning evening, Kindergarten on March 7th ,1st Grade on March 14, and 2nd Grade on March 21, 2013. The next BLT meeting is February 6, 2013. Mr. Schulman wished the community a happy new year, happy holidays and a Merry Christmas.

- □ Westlake Athletic Club: Mr. Anthony Sardo, President, reported that at their last meeting an expert on recruiting spoke about the pros and cons associated with recruiting; Mr. Sardo thanked Ms. Pirro for her assistance; two fundraisers, Silvio's and Anthony Botticelli/Extreme Training, raised in total approximately \$2,700 which went to the victims of Hurricane Sandy; Mr. Sardo thanked those who participated in the fundraising; upcoming fundraisers are the Night at the Races on January 18, 2013 and the golf outing on April 29, 2013. Mr. Sardo thanked Dr. Guiney, Dr. Hendrickson, Mr. Cunzio and Mr. Schulman on behalf of the Little Wildcats for the lacrosse program, 1st grade through 6th grade. Mr. Sardo wished everyone a happy holiday and a happy new year.

III. REPORTS

 President, Board of Education: Mr. James Grieco reported that last week the school district distributed a flyer to the residents in order to keep them informed on the challenges of the 2013/2014 school budget. After the flyer was received. the Board received letters and phone calls filled with concerns and misinformation. Mr. Grieco wanted to make it clear that nothing has been decided regarding the items listed on the flyer entitled, "At Stake Under The Tax Cap". The items listed are as follows: transportation, teacher layoffs, class size increases; program reductions; elective reductions including AP, extra-curricular activities; athletics; full-day kindergarten, support staff/custodial reductions. facilities maintenance/improvements and facilities use. Mr. Grieco again made it clear that no decisions have been made to cut any of these items. Mr. Grieco reported that in order to remain under the mandated 2% tax cap, the district needs to cut out almost \$2M, as the District has a \$2M deficit. Mr. Grieco continued the items listed are on the table for discussion as items that can help bridge the gap. Another choice is to exceed the tax cap with a "super majority" of 60% 'yes' votes on the budget. Last year, we only had 58% of the residents vote 'yes' and the budget was kept at the 2% tax cap. Overriding the 2% tax cap is a risk. Mr. Grieco continued by informing the residents that the Mount Pleasant Town Board unanimously voted to override the Town's 2% tax cap, in fact it is over 4%, as the Town only needs a super majority vote of the town board members as it does not go out for a public vote. Mr. Grieco invited and

- encouraged the community to attend budget meetings and forums and to be part of the discussions over the next couple of months regarding the budget.
- Superintendent of Schools: Dr. Susan Guiney reported it has been an emotional week in particular for those who work in the field of education as the Newton School District is one of our partners in the Tri-State Consortium. Dr. Guiney sends the District's best wishes and healing to Newtown. Dr. Guiney continued by reporting on the following: the District's security procedures and safety in our schools; a meeting with the Mount Pleasant Police Department and law enforcement officers; the security system, which is being funded through the EXCEL grant, will be functional during the month of January; swipe cards will be distributed to District employees which will enable employees access to entrances and exits in our buildings during the day, as the doors will be locked; surveillance cameras will be installed and the replacement of a number of doors to make them more secure. Dr. Guiney continued that the children's concert performances and art shows were wonderful and MSG Varsity visited the District during a wrestling match and will feature a segment on Mt. Pleasant on Thursday evening on the MSG Varsity Channel. Dr. Guiney concluded her report by wishing the staff and community a happy holiday season.
- Energy Education Update: Mr. Jerry Schulman, energy specialist, began his report by giving details on the energy shutdown in the schools during the holiday break and other times during the year. Mr. Schulman continued by saying that the District's e-map has been reviewed by individuals involved with Cenergistic, District Office administrators and District contractors to maximize energy conservation and savings. Mr. Schulman continued by noting that all of the schools, except Columbus Elementary School, heat with gas as it is more cost effective. Mr. Schulman concluded his report by thanking everyone for their commitment to energy conservation and savings.

RESOLUTION TO AMEND The Mt. Pleasant CSD 403(b) RETIREMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the Mt. Pleasant CSD ("Employer") maintains the Mt. Pleasant CSD 403(b) Retirement Plan Document ("Plan"); and

WHEREAS, the Plan was duly adopted on the 17th day of December, 2008, by the Employer; and

WHEREAS, the Employer desires to conform the Plan to the requirements of the Heroes Earnings Assistance and Relief Act of 2009 ("HEART") and the Worker, Retiree and Employer Recovery Act of 2008 ("WRERA");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that sections 1.16 Includible Compensation, 1.24 Severance from Employment, 4.1 Loans, and 5.3 Minimum Distributions, of the Plan are hereby amended to read as follows:

1.16 Includible Compensation

An Employee's actual wages in box 1 of Form W-2 for a year for services to the Employer, but subject to a maximum of \$200,000 (or such higher maximum as may apply under Section 401(a)(17) of the Code) and increased (up to the dollar maximum) by any compensation reduction election under Section 125, 132(f), 401(k), 403(b), or 457(b) of the Code (including any Elective Deferral under the Plan). The amount of Includible Compensation is determined without regard to any community property laws. Beginning in 2009 and thereafter, such term also includes any "differential pay" that may be received while performing qualified military service under Section 414(u) of the Code.

1.24 Severance from Employment

For purpose of the Plan, Severance from Employment means severance from employment with the Employer and any Related Entity. However, a Severance from Employment also occurs on any date on which an Employee ceases to be an employee of a public school, even though the Employee may continue to be employed by a Related Employer that is another unit of the State or local government that is not a public school or in a capacity that is not employment with a public school (e.g., ceasing to be an employee performing services for a public school but continuing to work for the same State or local government employer). Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, a Participant is treated as having a severance from employment during any period that such individual is performing service in the uniformed services described in Code §3401(h)(2)(A).

4.1 Loans

Loans shall be permitted under the Plan to the extent permitted by the Individual Agreements controlling the Account assets from which the loan is made and by which the loan will be secured. Any such loans shall satisfy the requirements of Code section 72(p) and applicable Treasury Regulations.

Loan applications shall be reviewed and authorized by the Employer's agent, i.e. third party administrator, and said agent shall inform the Service Provider of such authorization so as to proceed with the Service Provider's process of issuance of the loan.

Information Coordination Concerning Loans. Each Service Provider is responsible for all information reporting and tax withholding required by applicable federal and state law in connection with distributions and loans. To minimize the instances in which Participants have taxable income as a result of loans from the Plan, the Administrator shall take such steps as may be appropriate to coordinate the limitations on loans set forth in this Section, including the collection of information from Service Providers, and transmission of information requested by any Service Provider, concerning the outstanding balance of any loans made to a Participant under the Plan or any other plan of the Employer. The Administrator shall also take such steps as may be appropriate to collect information from Service Providers, and transmission of information to any Service Provider, concerning any failure by a Participant to repay timely any loans made to a Participant under the Plan or any other plan of the Employer.

Maximum Loan Amount. No loan to a Participant under the Plan may exceed the lesser of:

(a) \$50,000, reduced by the greater of (i) the outstanding balance on any loan from the Plan to the Participant on the date the loan is made or (ii) the highest outstanding balance on loans from the Plan to the Participant during the one-year

period ending on the day before the date the loan is approved by the Administrator (not taking into account any payments made during such one-year period); or

(b) One half of the value of the Participant's vested Account Balance (as of the valuation date immediately preceding the date on which such loan is approved by the Administrator).

For purposes of this Section 4.1, any loan from any other plan maintained by the Employer and any Related Employer shall be treated as if it were a loan made from the Plan, and the Participant's vested interest under any such other plan shall be considered a vested interest under this Plan; provided, however, that the provisions of this paragraph shall not be applied so as to allow the amount of a loan to exceed the amount that would otherwise be permitted in the absence of this paragraph.

Loan Repayments for Employees in Qualified Uniformed Service. Notwithstanding any other provision of an applicable Individual Agreement, loan repayments by eligible uniformed services personnel maybe suspended as permitted under Section 414(u)(4) of the Code and the terms of any loan shall be modified to conform with such requirements.

5.3 Minimum Distributions

Each Individual Agreement shall comply with the minimum distribution requirements of Section 401(a)(9) of the Code and the regulations thereunder. For purposes of applying the distribution rules of Section 401(a)(9) of the Code, each Individual Agreement is treated as an individual retirement account (IRA) and distributions shall be made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1.408-8 of the Income Tax Regulations, except as provided in Section 1.403(b)-6(e) of the Income Tax Regulations. Notwithstanding the preceding, any distributions otherwise required under this section for the 2009 tax year are waived in accordance with the provisions of the Worker, Retiree and Employer Recovery Act of 2008, unless such waiver cannot be accommodated under the Individual Agreement that governs a Participant's Account.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Plan shall include the following new sections 5.7 Qualified Military Service Distributions and 9.12 Qualified Military Service Benefits:

5.7 Qualified Military Service Distributions

Any Participant whose employment is interrupted by qualified uniformed service in the military under section 414(u) of the Code and dies or incurs a Disability while so serving shall be deemed to have resumed employment with the Employer on the day preceding such death or Disability and then to have incurred a Severance From Service on the actual date of death or Disability.

Any Participant that takes a distribution from the Plan under Section 414(u) following an interruption in employment that qualifies as qualified uniformed service thereunder may not make Elective Deferrals for a period of six (6) months following the date such distribution occurred.

9.12 Qualified Military Service Benefits

Notwithstanding any other provision of this Plan, any Participant whose employment is interrupted by qualified uniformed service in the military under section 414(u) of the Code shall be entitled to all rights, benefits and protections afforded to such individuals thereunder, and such provisions are incorporated into this Plan. Uniformed services by any individual shall be determined as described in section 3401(h)(2)(A) of the Code.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this amendment is effective as required under HEART and WRERA.
