APPLY TO SUNY FOR FREE! NO DEADLINE FOR LINCOLN STUDENTS!
FAFSA is going live in December!!! Stay tuned for more info.

How to apply to college:

1. Go to the college's website and look under admissions (www.cuny.edu, www.suny.edu, www.commonapp.org)
2. Create an account- you will need your social security number if you have one.
3. Complete all questions, copy and paste or upload your essay
4. Request Teacher Recommendations on Naviance (for all applications)
5. Pay your application fee or request a fee waiver
6. Update your Naviance account under 'colleges I'm applying to' so the College Office can send out your school documents. (link Commonapp to Naviance or click the + sign to add a non Commonapp college)
7. Send your SAT scores through College Board (unless your college is test optional or test blind)
8. Check your emails for updates from the college.
9. Send your acceptance letters to the College Office.
