 2. PCR and rapid both available, kids were able to use rapid - decrease fear factor if additional tests are needed in the future.
 - b. Might be able to test at school through Michelle via Hamilton County if we move to yellow zone
 - i. 20% of school population would need to be completed within 2 weeks.
 - ii. If the percentage of positive in school is lower than percent of positives in county, then we are able to return to school and no additional testing would be needed.
 - iii. Potential for moving right from orange, skipping yellow, based on governors new plan for winter
 - c. Dr. Rider has rapid test
