PBIS Grill and Chill: The PBIS Leadership team is hosting our first grill and chill this Friday, September 13th at the school. All funds will support our Positive School Climate initiative which is better known as "The Titan Way." Our funds will be spent on incentives for students and staff to help continue the 5 star climate rating that Oglethorpe Charter School achieved during the 2018-2019 school year. What is Grill and Chill? The Grill and Chill activity is hosted 5 times yearly by the Oglethorpe Charter School leadership clubs (Student Council, National Junior Honor Society, Future Business Leaders of America, BETA club and TSA club). Every student in the building has a 90 minute related arts time frame daily. The related arts classes are the non-core academic classes such as band, chorus, orchestra, PE, health, orchestra, marine science, Spanish, engineering, art and computer science. We basically have 3 grill outs in one day and our related arts teachers bring their 90 minute classes to the gym/concession area as well as our playing field area. The students are able to purchase freshly grilled hamburgers and hot dogs as well as other snack items. The students get to spend 90 minutes hanging out with their friends and can choose any activity they want to participate in and make as many trips to the food station as they want during this 90 minute time frame. Of all of the activities that we do at Oglethorpe, this is perhaps the most popular event with our kids. It takes a small army to pull this off. We are asking for parent volunteers this Friday for the following 90 minute time frames:

Mr. Case hosted the very first Grill and Chill 4 years ago when he started our Future Business Leaders of America club (FBLA). It was such a huge hit with the students that other leadership clubs over the years started hosting the event as well. The Grill and Chill event was made possible by our PTO purchasing a commercial grill 7 years ago. Our current PTO President (Yvonne Friedman) fed the entire school on the last day of school with this grill last year and purchased another commercial grill for this school year a few weeks ago.

Magic Mark: Magic Mark will be at Oglethorpe Charter School for the Cookie Dough Sale Kickoff assembly September 13th: We are using this event to not only promote the kick off of our PTO fundraiser but to also promote our PBIS initiative because many of the funds raised will go right back to our students. Students will have until October 9th to make sales. The PTO rents out the entire Star Castle facility for those students that sell one or more tubs of cookie dough. The students also get to eat out that day at the

Oglethorpe Mall food court. Parents also receive volunteer hours for tubs of cookie dough sold. This is a win-win fundraiser for all. Many parents use this fundraiser to fulfill their volunteer hours. Five volunteer hours will be awarded for each tub of cookie dough sold. If a student from a single parent family sales 2 tubs of cookie dough, the volunteer hours for the year have been met. If a child from a two parent family sells four tubs of cookie dough, the volunteer hours for the year have been met. Students in the past have won flat screen televisions and other electronics if they are the top sellers in the school.
