Assignment: KEITH HARING COLLABORATIVE MURAL

Students were introduced to Pop/Graffiti artist Keith Haring and his iconic style of art. Students were asked to come up with multiple designs that were interesting and had a theme using only Haring's cartoon style of drawing. Each table was asked to share their designs and combine the best aspects of each student in the group for a larger collaborative mural. Students were expected to work together to execute the chosen design by drawing multiple figures and objects and painting the mural with only 3 colors. Students were expected to create an interesting composition that utilized space and minimal color for a specified theme.

Students were graded individually on collaboration skills and communication, contributing at least 4-5 figures in the design, daily participation, evidence of individual planning and design.

Tables were graded collaboratively on evidence of planning, color choice, craftsmanship, the use of space and form, and understanding /following project expectations.
