


Teacher Tips:

- 1. Copy the above maps and descriptions onto a white piece of 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ × 11" piece of paper.
- 2. fold a piece of colorful paper in half, hamburger fold.
- 3. Cut out the 1861 map of Virginia and glue on the top of the foldable.
- 4. Cut out the 1863 map showing both Virginia and the newly created West Virginia on the inside of the foldable.
- 5. On the top part of the inside, have students create drawings to show what caused the disagreement and why the state split.
