

Special Services for Students with Disabilities

A student who has an individualized education program (IEP) through the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act, or is receiving services under Section 504, will be provided some, or all, of the identified services through the alternate or additional methods. Students with disabilities have the opportunities to have access to high-quality educational instruction during the extended school closure, especially during this time of continuing education through distance learning. Once school resumes, school will provide special education and related services to students with disabilities in accordance with the student's IEP or, for students entitled to FAPE under Section 504, consistent with any plan developed to meet the requirements of Section 504. Simply stated, your child will continue to receive services to enable them to access learning through distance learning platforms. Special education teachers will be in contact with parents to discuss the specific needs of your child.
