Parents Bill of Rights for Data Privacy and Security

Pursuant to Section 2-c and 2-d of the Education Law, parents and students are entitled to certain protections regarding confidential student information. The district is committed to safeguarding personally identifiable information from unauthorized access or disclosure as set forth below:

- 1. A student's personally identifiable information cannot be sold or released for any commercial purposes;
- 2. Parents have the right to inspect and review the complete contents of their child's education record;
- 3. The District is committed to implementing safeguards associated with industry standards and best practice under state and federal laws protecting the confidentiality of personally identifiable information
- 4. Parents have the right to have complaints about possible breaches of student data addressed. In the event that the district engages a third party provider to deliver student educational services, the contractor or subcontractors will be obligated to adhere to State and Federal Laws to safeguard student PII.
