Four Meetings- May 15th, June 12th, July 8th and October 31st


Developed & Distributed an online Communications Survey

District Survey


- Survey was released in August

How do you keep up to date with school events?


(Check all that apply)




How would you like us to communicate with you regarding the school and community? (Check all that apply)

- Develop a Promotion Pamphlet
- Create a School Directory Bookmark
- Plan Website Access Workshops & Instructions
- Develop the Parent Academic Portal

What have we done?

- Blackboard Connect Accepted 2 e-mails per student to be automatically imported by the district.
- The system automatically cancels repeated phone numbers and addresses so if a parent has provided their e-mail with 2 students they will only receive one phone call or e-mail.

Where are we?

- E-mail addresses have been secured for parents and teachers are using them regularly for focused e-mails
- Pamphlet needs to be developed
- Work with BOCES to open the Parent Portal through eSchoolData
- School Directory Bookmark will be available Spring 2014
- Website Webinars will be available Spring 2014
