Dear BHSWCA Families and Students,

Hard to believe this school year is coming to an end already. It is almost time for our Summer Rising program which starts **July 12th at 9 am in person**. Summer Rising is the *NEW* summer learning program, open to **ALL** students from July 12 - August 12 from 9 am - 4 pm from Monday-Thursday. Students will have an opportunity to make up incomplete coursework, also know as NX grades, **in person**. Students can also join theatre with Epic Theatre from 9:30-11. Afrobeats and African dance with Kuumba and a mural project with Community Word Project will also be offered from 1-4 pm. We will send out an interest form to your email this week. Please stay tuned.

We are looking forward to celebrating our graduating seniors! Our outdoor graduation ceremony is Thursday, June 24th from 11am - 12 pm. Our virtual ceremony is June 25th from 2 pm-3:20 pm, which is also the last day of school. We hope you will use the link to join us!

Next year, school year will begin on September 13th. All students are expected to return to the building unless they qualify for home instruction, which will be taught remotely by DoE teachers not from our school. 8) CIA Undergraduate Scholarship Program - \$18,000 - 10 Awards (Deadline: June 18, 2021)

To be eligible for the scholarship a student must:

A) Have scored at least 1000 on the SAT or 21 on the ACT.

B) Demonstrate financial need and have at least a 3.0 GPA on a 4-point scale.
