Academic Intervention Services Program 2018-19

Overview:

The Port Chester Public Schools provides Academic Intervention Services (AIS) to students during the school day who demonstrate they are at risk of not achieving the New York State Learning Standards. AIS is designed to help eligible students achieve the NYS Learning Standards in English language arts and mathematics. Additional instruction may include whole group, small group or individual instruction that supplements the general curriculum.

The intensity of AIS may vary. It is designed to respond to student needs as indicated through a variety of assessment measures.

Eligibility for Academic Intervention Services:

In compliance with the regulations from the State Education Department of New York, students are identified for AIS through a two step process.

Step 1: All students performing below the median scale score between a level 2 (partially proficient) and level 3 (proficient) on a grade 3-8 English language arts (ELA) or mathematics state assessment shall be considered for AIS. (Document A)

Step 2: A district developed procedure (outlined below) is applied at each grade level to determine which students shall receive AIS. (Document B)

After the district considers a student's scores on multiple measures of student performance, the district determines whether the student is required to receive AIS.
