- All student must remain in his/her exam location for the entire length
  of the exam, and until dismissed by the exam proctor. The College
  Board DOES NOT permit students to leave if they have finished the
  exam early. This also holds true for students who receive extended time.
  You must remain in your testing location and use all of your extended
  time.
- Students should not bring electronic devices of any kind (cell phones, smart watches, laptops, Bluetooth devices, devices that can access the internet or any other electronic or communication devices) into the exam room. If they are in your possession when you arrive at your testing location, they will be collected and given back to you at the end of the exam.
