UFT Town Hall Meeting:

- 1. UFT President thinks schools probably won't open in September (60-40% we do not open)
- 2. Safety measures with school teams: Safety/BRT Team needs to meet
- 3. Synchronous teaching model
- 4. Checking school ventilation systems, heating/cooling systems, windows...
- 5. Heroes Act to prevent layoffs
- 1. Summer Planning: Teachers are considering the I-learn Platform
- 2. Surveys:
 - a. Teaching Models 1A vs 1B:
 - b. Teachers embraced 1A; Parents embraced 1B.

Laura must submit a proposal for approval (1A or 1B) in early August

- 3. Still concerns regarding "Live Instruction;" parents want to see more live teaching.
- 4. Concerned about ICT Classes and if both teachers will be assigned to a group of 12?
- 5. Finding rooms within school is a big challenge. We will use cluster rooms, especially if we need to assign one additional certified teacher to each grade
- 6. Discussion regarding the feasibility of outdoor classrooms
- 7. Lunchroom: For safety, survey showed a preference for lunch in the classroom rather than the Cafeteria
- 8. Recess: Survey results show that having Recess is very important. We are awaiting DOE mandates
- 9. Teacher Survey Results: In favor of 1st Period Prep: 50%
- 10. Zoom: Add a 15 min snack break in the schedule to Zoom with remote kids daily; a majority like the idea
- 11. Teaching 3 consecutive periods, then a break as per UFT contract; who will cover the teacher on their prep? Who will cover teachers in the classroom when the teachers have their duty free lunch? How Can Extended Day Help?
