SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION OF STUDENTS

Transportation To and From Schools

The transportation of the students to and from school will be provided by the sending school district.

Transportation to School-Sponsored Events

Transportation will be provided by the District for school-sponsored activities by contracting for service with approved suitable vendors in accordance with state law and regulations. Where the District has provided transportation to students enrolled in the District to a school-sponsored field trip, extracurricular activity, or any other similar event, it will also provide transportation back to either the point of departure unless a student's parent or legal guardian has provided the District with written notice, consistent with District policy, authorizing an alternative form of return transportation for the student. In cases where intervening circumstances make transportation of a student back to the point of departure impractical, and the parent has not authorized alternative return transportation, a representative of the District will remain with the student until the student's parent or legal guardian has been contacted and informed of the intervening circumstances and the student has been delivered to his or her parent.

Transportation in Personal Vehicles

Personal cars of teachers and staff will not be used to transport students except in the event of extenuating circumstances and authorized by the administration.
