(1) Call to order: meeting called to order at 7:45am.

(2) Review and approval of minutes: Minutes from the last meeting were approved.

(3) Middle School

- Collecting photos of remote learning for yearbook;
- 5<sup>th</sup> graders will get souvenir bag for graduation;
- June 19<sup>th</sup> graduation date: in-class personalized graduation (just parents invited) and then virtual gathering of entire grade (slide/music show for presentation and Laura will do speech);
- Families will get most money back for graduation fees;
- Middle schools setting up virtual tours;
- Possibility of in-person, distanced interaction with Laura as send-off;
- Revive work on website: materials for incoming 5<sup>th</sup> graders for middle school orientation (can post virtual tours);
- Plan to put together meeting for rising 4<sup>th</sup> grade parents about middle school (bring in parents who already have middle schoolers);
- Suggestion to create online forum to exchange questions and experiences.

(4) CEP

- Training available for SLT members;
- SLT needs to review how school did with CEP goals
- Request for suggestions for future CEP goals:
  - Include something about remote learning.

(5) Remote learning

- Set up sub-committees among SLT members to come up with ideas/plans for the Fall (but need some more guidance on discretion at school level);
- Google classroom will be kept open during the summer as a resource bank for families;
- Considering aligned curriculum across grade and *how* it is delivered (i.e. focus on live instruction across all classes).

(6) Elections

- SLT needs to replace Jill's position and the PTA will put out call for nominations;
- All elections have been pushed back to October (although an earlier election is permitted).

(7) Title I

- Workshop coming up: "When to Worry about your Child Worries".

(8) Miscellaneous

- Need to complete SLT remuneration forms: they will be sent electronically (please return to Ali);
- No updates on budgets for PS10; budget looks good for K280 (no 3K happening);
- The administration is monitoring Pre-K and K enrollment;
- The school is still considering options for articulation for next year: how to address gaps in learning and support a wide range of those gaps in re-entry next year;
- SLT training will take place this week.
