How are WISE projects evaluated?

- 1. The mentor will provide frequent feedback to the student about his/her project. The WISE rubric will serve as guidance for both students and mentors.
- 2. The mentor will complete an interim report at the end of the third marking period. This report will be mailed home.
- 3. If the project includes an internship, the on-site mentor will also complete an evaluation report which will be included with the mentor's interim report.
- 4. Mentors will complete a final evaluation report. This will include a discussion of the project, commentary on the student's successes and areas in need of improvement, documentation of the evaluation committees commendations and recommendations, and observations from the on-site mentor (if applicable). This report will be sent to the student's parents/guardians and become part of the student's permanent transcript.
- 5. Mentors will give each student a final grade of pass with honors, pass or fail. This grade will become part of the student's final transcript.
