Ink Pens (Dark Blue or Black)	1 pkg (minimum 4)
Ink Pens (Multicolor)	1 pkg (4-8 colors)
No. 2 Pencils	Minimum 10-12
Folders w/pockets (with or without prongs)	6-8
Colored pencils	1 pkg (at least 8 pencils)
Scientific Calculator (recommended models TI30XS, TI30Xa)	1
Pencil Sharpener (hand held with case for shavings)	1
Pencil Pouch or Case for Supplies	1
Highlighters	1 pkg of 4
12-inch Ruler	1
Dry Erase Markers	1 pkg of 4 or 8
Glue Stick	2-4 Sticks
Post-It Notes (no larger than 3x3 inch)	2-4 pads
Permanent markers	1 pkg of at least 8 markers
