- Mike mentioned again the involvement he's had over the past half-year with Hamilton County and the development of a county-wide Crisis Response Team. Rob (who was at the October HWS meeting) indicated that he was interested in being on the "Hamilton County North" team.
- Duane again brought up a good question: How would leaving school "at a moment's notice" work logistically in terms of team members' classes and other responsibilities? This would have to be discussed ahead of time, through written guidelines. For instance, it may be very difficult for Tina (as an elementary teacher) to leave the school to assist. Team member suggestions at this time: Duane Finch, Tina Pine, Emily Blanchard, Rob Linhart, Tony Clark, Vickie Snide, Mike Corey, Angie Gaudet, Jeanne Kozloski, Carl Turner were all mentioned as potential names.
- Duane stated that he had been in touch with Carl re: food deliveries with the doors left open for a period of time. In general, there needs to be better accounting of non-staff people within the building.
- All agreed that the bulletin board on the wall near the 3-4 and 5-6 classrooms looks good. Thanks to all for contributing snapshots of healthy staff activities.
- There was discussion of a Health and Fitness day in the spring, which was brought up by Tina and Emily at the 11/16 HSW Committee meeting that many folks could not get to. Perhaps a half- day devoted to being active and learning about health.
