Travel:

The Amtrak train for Albany is not going to work, even the earliest train at like 6 a.m. goes to NYC then to Boston...we would not get to Boston until like 2 p.m.

There is a train that leaves Albany at around 3:20 p.m. that goes to Boston, avoiding NYC and that arrives at like 8:30 p.m.

Drive to North Quincy, MA (297 miles, 4 hours 52 minutes), can take subway to get around-North Quincy station is like a 5 minute or less walk from hotel \$11 per person for a 1 day (24 hour) pass

Sights:

Science Museum-we need like 4-5 hours there, open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. admission \$29 per person

Duck Boats-80 minutes and they leave from New England Aquarium & Science Museum, 9 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. departures you can get \$10 off with a discount code so it's \$39.99 per person
