October, 2022


Old Business:

1. Emergency Bus Evacuation Drill was held on 3/16/2022
2. Starting 1/4/22, our local public health is providing Hamilton County school districts with weekly supplies of At-Home COVID Test Kits to be available for students/staff to use at onset of symptoms or exposure. Tests were sent home with all students, faculty, staff before February Break with instructions to test before returning to school. No positive results reported.
3. From 2/1/22-2/28/22, LLCS Health Office performed 35 COVID-19 tests: 29- students with 0 positives and 6-staff with 0 positives.
4. Fitness center is being utilized for weight-training students during school hours. Plan to open the fitness center to faculty/staff after school dismissal.
5. Discuss a Spring Fitness challenge for faculty/staff
6. Long Lake Lions Club is applying for another matching grant to fund our Backpack Program for the 2022-2023 school year.
