Writing

Opinion Writing

We have also begun a new unit in our Writer's Workshop. We are learning about Opinion Writing and the different techniques author's use in persuasive writing. During this unit, the students will study various forms of opinion writing and will apply their new skills to their own persuasive writing.

Reading

Reading the Weather, Reading the World

We have begun a new unit in our Reader's Workshop, titled Reading the Weather, Reading the World. This unit is all about reading expository, or nonfiction texts, and noticing the text features that make this genre unique. Students will focus on uncovering the main idea of a text and the supporting details the author uses to support their ideas in their writing. During this unit, the students will also participate in a research project in small groups where they will be researching topics using expository texts and teaching others on that topic.

Math

Eureka Math Module 4

Lines & Angles

Students will be exploring the different kinds of lines, such as parallel, perpendicular, rays, and points. The children will be learning how to identify and measure different types of angles using a protractor. They will learn key terms such as acute angles, obtuse angles, right angles and straight angles.

Social Studies

Using Passport to Social Studies, learners will explore a variety of digital and print resources to understand the Native American history of New York State. The children will be conducting research projects on this topic as part of Unit 2 in Reading.
