Code of Ethics Steger School District 194

- Serve as a positive role model for students, fellow employees, parents, and the community.
- Create, support, and maintain a positive work environment.
- Work collaboratively with all members of the school district and community.
- Demonstrate commitment to learning by engaging in professional growth.

It is the belief of Steger School District 194 that the ethical conduct demonstrated by its employees influences the well-being of students, staff, and community.
