Online/ Remote Learning Etiquette	Be sure that you're only attending virtual classes that are on your schedule Turn camera on if you're able to; communicate with your teacher if you have connection issues or are not comfortable turning your camera on	Mute your mic unless you're speaking and use the chat function (if available) for questions/comments so you don't interrupt instruction Be mindful of what you share in the chat and show on camera - there is inherently less privacy online Practice patience with yourselves and others as we all navigate remote learning/ technology	Ask questions if you're having technology or internet challenges If you encounter something inappropriate or unsafe online, communicate the situation to a trusted adult for guidance Participate in the lesson to demonstrate understanding and active participation
Covid-19 Protocols	Be mindful of your space and belongings Engage with touch free greetings with peers/staff	Maintain a safe distance in school by staying 3 feet apart Wear your mask properly (over the nose and mouth) Practice frequent handwashing	Get tested frequently and follow CDC Covid-19 guidelines Clean and disinfect your space/laptop regularly Set an example for others
