- Tutoring plans

  - 100 names read at mass during the opening procession
  - During the opening procession, students will be carrying flowers for each name. Students are needed for each name and flower.
  - In conjunction with Student Council and Friends
  - All NHS members will be participating. If you won't be in school, let Mrs. Farrell or NHS officers know.
- Dues
  - Dues need to be in ASAP.
  - \$15 per NHS member

- Blood Drive
  - Goal: to do two blood drives in the second half of the school year
  - First blood drive in January
