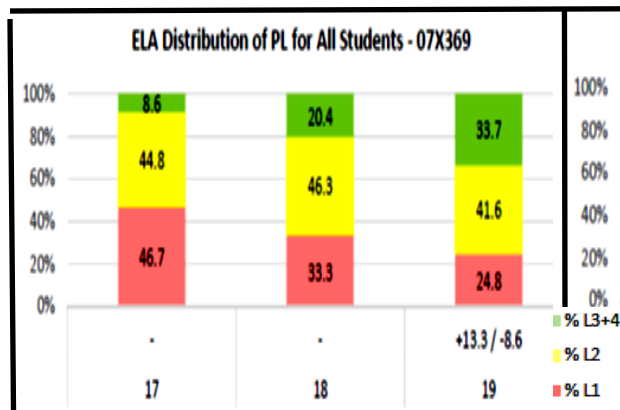

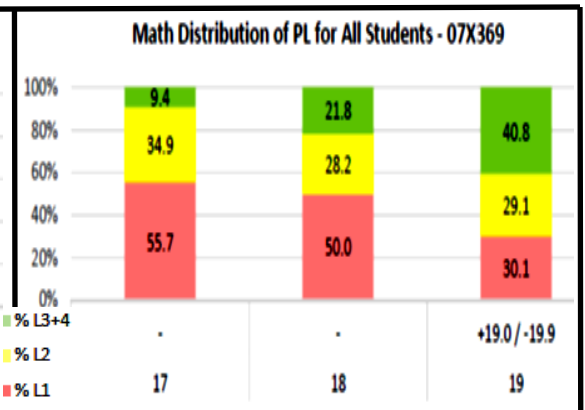

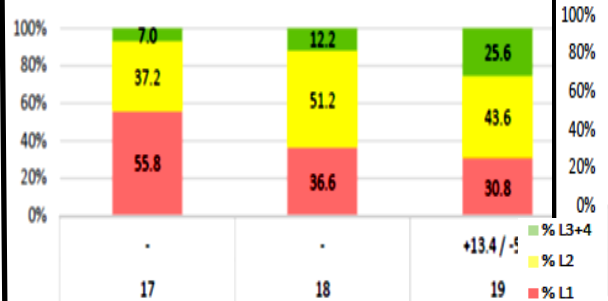
How Are Our Students Performing in ELA?



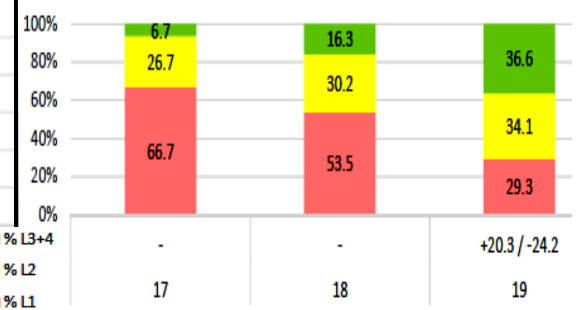
How Are Our Students Performing in Math?



ELA Distribution of PL for ELL - 07X369



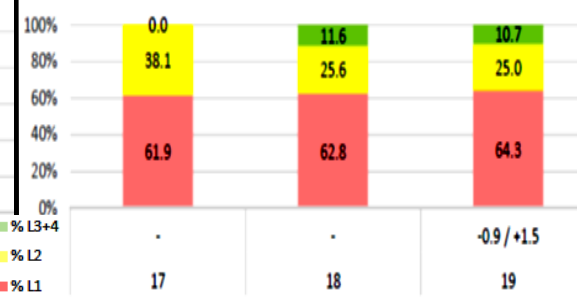
Math Distribution of PL for ELL - 07X369
