#### **State Testing – Past and Future: Theme of Change**

- <u>2013</u>: NYS administered the first new tests aligned to Common Core Standards in ELA and math. Scores dropped across NYS.
- 2014: The lengths of the 3-8 ELA and math tests were slightly reduced.
- 2016: The 3-8 ELA and math tests were redesigned to include fewer items, and the tests became untimed; thus, the 2016 results could not be compared to previous years.
- 2018: The 3-8 ELA and math tests were reduced to two days and aligned to new performance standards with a new scale scoring system; thus, the 2018 results cannot be compared to previous years.
- 2019: Pocantico Hills will join the growing list of NYS Districts piloting Computer-Based Testing instead of Paper-Based Testing in selected grades.
- 2020: NYSED is currently expecting Districts to be The lengths of the 3-8 ELA and math tests were slightly reduced.

#### From the NYS Commissioner


• 2016: "While the content of the 2016 tests and last year's tests are comparable and similarly rigorous, it is not possible to make direct comparisons of the 2016 results to prior years' results because of changes to the tests this year."

• 2018: "Due to the State's new two-session test design and performance standards, the 2018 Grades 3-8 ELA and math <u>results</u> cannot be compared with prioryear results. The new baseline established this year will enable comparisons with student scores in 2019 and 2020."



#### 5 Years of Progress: Tracking Each Cohort's Performance from 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade through 8<sup>th</sup> Grade




Combined Average ELA & Math:

In Westchester, By Cohort Over Time








Algebra Regents: 3-Year Cumulative Success Rate

By Performance Level




Algebra: 3-Year Cumulative Algebra Enrollment as a Percentage of Total 3-Year Cohort Enrollment




Pocantico Hills' open enrollment for Algebra draws a broad spectrum and significantly higher percentage of 8<sup>th</sup> grade students into the class each year.





Acronym	Measure Name	What the student does
ORF	Oral Reading Fluency	Student reads a story aloud for one minute.
RC	Reading Comprehension	Student reads six passages of text and answers four multiple-choice questions about each passage. 24 total items.  Benchmark screening only.
SRF	Silent Reading Fluency	Student reads three stories (each divided into four brief segments) and answers four multiple-choice questions about each story (one question per segment). Student is timed while reading the segments. 12 total items.
VOC	Vocabulary	Student identifies the meanings of target words by selecting from multiple-choice options. 16 items for 2nd grade. 22 items for grades 3 and up. Benchmark only.





Acronym	Measure Name	What the student does:
CA	Concepts & Applications	Student solves multiple-choice math word problems. 30 items total. Benchmark only.
MCF	Mental Computation Fluency	Student mentally solves multiple-choice math computation problems for four minutes.
NCF-T	Number Comparison Fluency- Triads	Student mentally solves multiple-choice math problems, each requiring the student to assess magnitude while comparing a set of three numbers for three minutes.
NSF	Number Sense Fluency	This is a summary of performance from the Number Comparison Fluency-Triads and Mental Computation Fluency tests.








### Pocantico Hills – HS Graduating Class of 2018: 29 Students Graduation Distribution in Partner High Schools







#### An Educational History of the Class of 2018












### Educational History: 2-Year Comparison









## Pocantico Hills Graduating Class of 2018 Average Scores on Regents Exams

(Number of Pocantico Tests Taken in Parentheses)




### Pocantico Hills Graduating Class of 2018 AP Course Enrollment & Performance on AP Exams





### Pocantico Hills Graduating Class of 2018 Average SAT Scores




## Pocantico Hills Graduating Class of 2018 Average ACT Scores


## Pocantico Hills Graduating Class of 2018 Participation in Section 1 Athletics






### Pocantico Hills Graduating Class of 2018 College Attendance
