## How it Works

- To add text to the outline and sources to the Bibliographer:
- 1. Click to open the **Note** tab.
- 2. Click **NEW** and type the name of the **Note**.
- 3. Highlight text you want to place in the outline.
- 5. The text goes into outline with its citation and the source is entered in the Bibliographer.



#### **How it Works**





## Text Reader 1

Reads PDFs and most text on websites





- 2. Click the word where you want to start reading.
- 3. Click anywhere on the screen to stop reading.



## Text Reader 2

Reads text that Text Reader 1 will not read



- 1. Click
- 2. Draw a box around the text you want to read.
- 3. If you want to stop reading, click anywhere in the box.



#### Text Leveler

Changes hard words to words that are easier to understand.
