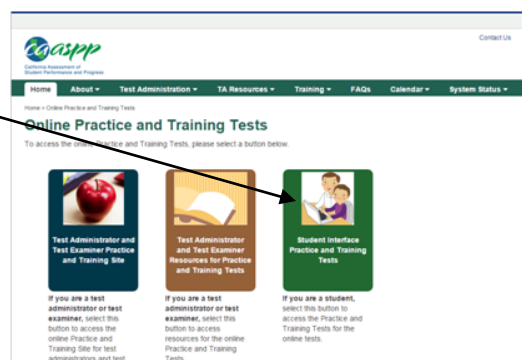
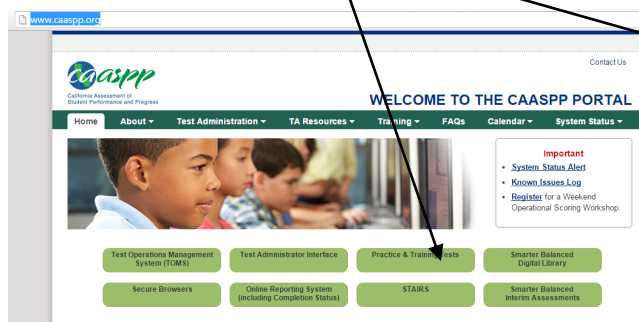

California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) for 3rd -8th Grade

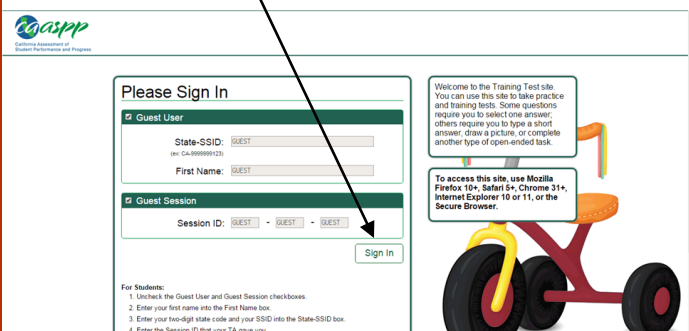
This year, our Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium for CAASPP testing window is approximately twelve weeks. Students have already been taking practice tests and took interim assessments this week for additional practice with the concepts and navigating the interface. Upper elementary will start us off on April 5th. The testing calendar will go out next week. We encourage parents to check out the practice tests on the CAASPP to get a better idea of what type of questions are being asked and technological skills students are using.

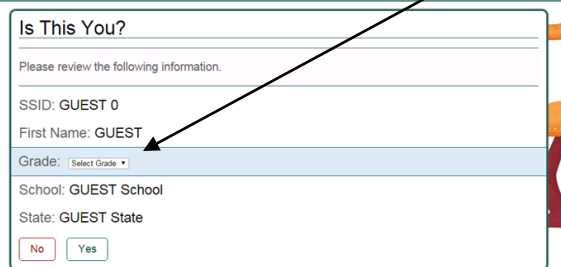
