Parent-Teacher Fundraising Committee

The PTFC is proud to report that in the 2014/2015 school year we raised \$37,700 from both small and large fundraising events such as the Harvest Festival and Fun Run, which are our two biggest and most successful fundraisers. Based on projections from last year's record breaking fundraising, the PTFC's goal for the 2015/16 school year is to raise \$38,000. We are confident that with help and support from our CMP community, we can achieve this fundraising goal!

The money that is raised through fundraising events is allocated as follows: 20% of profits go directly to the Bradshaw playground account and 10% is immediately allocated to the General Campus Fund for campus enrichment projects that are not covered by the school budget.

The remainder is held in an account and funds are then distributed to classrooms the following school year. For the 2015/16 school year, we will be able to allocate almost \$800 to each classroom. This is the first year we have been able to disperse funds raised by the PTFC directly to classrooms for specific needs such as art projects, practical life jobs, class plays & events, classroom materials, cultural awareness, etc. We hope that with continued successful fundraising, made possible by your participation in events, we can increase the amount allocated to classrooms next year.

Don't miss it *TOMORROW*, September 11th (9/11), from 5:00p-7:00p at the Elk Grove site! *FREE* ice cream will be provided to each CMP student!!!
