Strings class will be held after school on Tuesdays and is open to both new and continuing students in the 1st – 8th grades. Class begins at 3:10, and younger students will be dismissed at 3:50. Older beginners and continuing students (by teacher recommendation) will be dismissed at 4:30.*

Students will learn strong fundamentals through fun exercises, activities and folk songs. Note reading will be introduced in the beginning of year 2.

Tuition is \$215 per 13-week semester plus a once-yearly materials and enrollment fee of \$20. Students must provide their own instruments, and older students will need to bring a folding music stand to class. New beginners do not need an instrument at the first class. Space is limited to 18 students per class. Classes start Oct. 4th. *
