All these supplies can be found at Hobby Lobby. Some can be found at Walmart.

My hope is that if they each have their own pencil bag of basic supplies, the materials will be more respected, since they must keep track of, and take care of their own. Feel free to label their supplies with a piece of tape with their name on it.

In general they will leave their pencil bags and sketchbooks in the classroom.

- 1. Pencil case: (K-8th) No larger than 8.5" x 6", soft case with zipper.
  - a. LABEL WITH CHILD's NAME
  - b. It can be anyone your child likes, one they are excited to use!
  - c. The following supplies should fit in their pencil case.
- 2. (K-8th) Three #2 regular, lead pencils (aka HB)
- 3. (3rd-8th) One 2H pencil, One 2B pencil, and One 6B pencil
- 4. (3rd-8th) A click eraser
  - a. Something like this:

- 7. (2nd-8th) Two black sharpies (They usually come in a pack)
- 8. (2nd-8th) Colored sharpies (an 8 pack or less, any color shades they like!)
  - a. Can find these at Hobby Lobby or Walmart.
- 9. (K-8th) 2 regular ball point writing pens (any color they like)
- 10. (K-2nd) One (6 oz or 7.6 oz) Elmer's Washable School glue
  - a. I will refill the bottles throughout the year.
- 11. (3rd-8th) One (6 oz or 7.6 oz) Elmer's Glue All, Multipurpose
- 12. (K-8th) Pack of three, Elmer's Glue Sticks
  - a. K-2nd may use colored glue, other grades regular clear/white
- 13. (K-8th) A sketchbook
  - a. LABEL WITH CHILD'S NAME
  - b. Anyone they like, one they are excited about, no bigger than 9' x 12'
  - c. Spiral bound is nice
  - d. Perforated pages are also a plus.
