Dress Code

The following regulations should be kept in mind when purchase school clothes for the school year.

- Shirts should be:
 - Navy blue or white
 - Oxford or polo with small or no logo
 - Tucked in at all times
- Undershirts should be:
 - White ONLY
- Spirit Shirts should:
 - Be worn on game days only or
 - Be worn once per month on meeting days
- Pants should:
 - Be worn at the waist
 - Be khaki
 - Not have holes or tears
 - Not be cut off or cargo
 - Not be joggers
- Shorts/Skirts should:
 - Be khaki
 - Be no shorter than 4 inches from the back crease of the knee
 - Not be cut off or cargo
- Belts should:
 - Be worn at all times
 - Not have a belt buckle bigger than your school ID
 - Not have studs or grommets
 - Be black, brown, or white & plain
- Socks should:
 - Be worn at all times
 - Match
- Shoes should
 - Be closed back and closed toe
 - Have a hard bottom (NO slippers)

- Jackets should be:
 - School appropriate (flannel or long sleeved shirts are NOT considered jackets)
- Hoodies:
 - Are NEVER allowed
- Pullovers, sweatshirts, sweaters should:
 - Be RMS colors of blue, yellow or white WITHOUT hood, labels, logos, print, or embroidery
- Hair should be
 - Appropriately groomed
 - Colored natural (NO pink, green, blue, etc.)
 - Clear of wraps, caps, bandanas, etc.
- Piercings:
 - NO facial piercings
 - Earrings not to exceed size of quarter
- Facial hair should be:
 - Reasonably trimmed mustache that covers upper lip and neatly trimmed facial hair are permitted
- **ID Tags** should be:
 - Issued during first week of school
 - Worn on top right collar, facing forward
 - Worn at all times while on campus
 - Unmarked & sticker free
