

### **Directions to general parking when attending a Burkeville ISD event, including athletic events.**

The most utilized access to the Burkeville ISD parking facilities is from Highway 63. From that point you will turn onto county roads 2096 or 2098. Either road will take you to Mustang Gymnasium, as 2096 runs behind the gym and 2098, which turns into Mustang Blvd., runs in front of the gym. Once you enter the School area, there is a road that connects both 2096 and 2098, and that is county road 2099, also referred to as Bearkat Drive. At this point you will see a large parking area between a majority of the buildings, including the Learning Center, and the Gymnasium. We have added some pictures that may be of help also. A couple of notes: Highway 63 runs east and west and the ISD is north of Highway 63. The Football stadium is located behind the facility in this picture (Jr. and Sr. High School). Visitor entrance to the Football Stadium is accessed by going around the left side of the building. A sidewalk runs down the left side of the building all the way to the gate. Home access is to the right of the building.

You took 2098 at the highway (63), and now you are at this stop sign. From this point, which is just across the street from the BISD facilities, you will easily see when you look to your right the general parking area. Straight ahead is Mustang Blvd.



Mustang Blvd. provides access to handicap, band, cheerleaders, security, and emergency vehicles. There are a few parking spaces for the general public right in front of the Gym which you can use, but only right in front of the gym.
