ART Contest



We invite all CMP students to participate in our 10th annual greeting card art contest. The greeting card will be sent to staff, Board Members, Community Representatives and vendors in addition to being placed on our website. None of the artwork will be used for commercial purposes. Contest Rules and Regulations are as follows:

1. Entry Period

Entries must be submitted no later than **October 21st, 2016** to your campus office.

2. Eligibility: Open to all current CMP students.

3. Rules of Entry: Submissions will become the property of CMP Central Administration.

4. Theme of Artwork

Artwork must be based upon the overall **WINTER/HOLIDAY** theme and for those who want a more specific theme we have chosen: **“The Gift of Giving”**.

5. Specification for Submissions

Only individual and original artwork may be submitted. All mediums (crayons, colored pencils, markers, pastels etc.) accepted. **Art must be on accompanied entry form or attached to entry form.**

6. Entry Form

An entry form is attached. Please make sure you fill in your campus, your name, classroom/teacher, grade and the title of your artwork in the designated spots.

7. Where to submit

Submit all entries to your teacher, who will pass them onto the campus Principal, who will take them to the Central Administration office for voting.

8. Judging Criteria

Entries will be evaluated by the Central Administration Team. Artwork will be judged on artistic merit and creativity.

9. Prizes

The chosen artwork designer from each campus will receive a gift card to Barnes and Noble, certificate of achievement, and 20 award winning cards. Artwork may also be displayed on the CMP website and recognized in your campus newsletter.
