Manhattan Village Academy is a rigorous, selective, screened collegepreparatory school. Before you make the decision to apply, please read:

#### • **Selection Criteria** include:

- o Attendance and Punctuality in middle school
- Open House Attendance (strong consideration granted to those who attended – <u>attendance is encouraged but NOT required</u>)
- o **Middle School Averages:** English (80-100), Math (80-100), Science (80-100), Social Studies (80-100)
- o **Standardized Test Scores** Math levels: 2-4 and English levels: 2-4

## • Students who apply to Manhattan Village Academy are expected to commit to the following:

- o Students wear the official MVA school uniform and black shoes.
- Incoming ninth graders (and tenth-grade transfer students) are required to attend the four-week Summer Bridge/Critical Thinking Program in July. This is an intensive enrichment course, not a remediation class. Students will receive course credit on their transcripts.
- Students are expected to attend PM School (3:00 pm -5:00 pm) during the weekdays, and Saturday Academy (10:00 am 2:00 pm) on the weekends.
  Both are scheduled by teachers on a need-basis; in other words, they are not held every single day, nor every single Saturday. Students and parents will be notified in advance.
- Manhattan Village Academy students are required to take all TEN of the New York State Regents Exams that are required for the <u>Advanced Regents</u> <u>Diploma</u>, <u>AS WELL AS</u> complete FIVE <u>Portfolios</u>: there are one to two portfolios in each grade of high school, and they span various disciplines.
- Students are to partake in **overnight college trips** during their sophomore and junior years.
- o Students are to take **Advanced Placement Courses.**
- Students are to maintain excellent Attendance and Punctuality.

#### **College Readiness:**

Students could apply to the CUNY <u>College Now</u> program, enabling them to take college-level classes at various institutions around NYC such as CUNY Hunter, CUNY Baruch, and NYU. There are also <u>SAT preparatory classes</u> scheduled during the school day for 9th, 10th and 11th graders. Additionally, MVA students participate in <u>CUNY STEP</u> (Science and Technology Entry Program) and internships via the non-profit <u>First Workings</u>.
