Construction Updates

On paper construction around P.S. 30 will be complete by April 2020. If construction is not done by then they will continue to work to complete the job, but the workers will stop getting paid. Auditorium Upgrade

We received 300,00 dollars for the auditorium upgrade, We are looking to get new curtains, maybe new window coverings. We are getting new wood on the seats, we cannot replace the seats. Air conditioning is not an option because it costs half a million dollars. This will be done over the summer, so it will not disrupt anything. Ms. Tozzi and Ms. Mezzadri asked if it was possible to get four ceiling fans for the auditorium and Mr. Ihne responded, "not sure if possible," but we will definitely ask for it. Painting the auditorium will be done after the roof is done, this means painting will not be done until 2020. They will not be touching any stage lights or repairing the floor.

Technology grant

We received 50,000 dollars from Mike Cusick. We purchased flat screen promethean boards for the fifth-grade classes. The cost of these smartboards were five thousand dollars each. Mr. Ihne also purchased 32 iPads, along with a cart for the iPads. There is about eight thousand dollars left. Mr. Ihne will be setting a meeting with the grade leaders and discuss how the eight thousand can be used.

National Association for Education Progress. Fifty fourth graders have been chosen to take the test online. They will be tested on either Math or ELA. This will take place on February 7, 2019. Letters went home to the students that were chosen.

Zoo Program

Mr. Napolitano got the maker space truck to come in May for four classes at P.S. 30. We also had it last year.
