The PINES e-card is a unique doorway to great digital services that are accessible immediately after filling out the online application!

To sign up for a PINES e-card, simply follow the link below. Applicants below the age of 18 will need consent from a parent or guardian to complete the application.

While the PINES e-card cannot circulate physical items, it grants access to all of our e-resources with the benefit of being completely free and without risk of any fines.

If you'd like to upgrade to a full PINES card in order to check out library books and other materials, you can bring your e-card account number and your photo ID to any PINES library to have the card upgraded.



Georgia Library Learning Online (GALILEO) is an online library portal filled with over 100 databases indexing thousands of periodicals and scholarly journals. The portal also contains encyclopedias, government publications, and many other resources.

Once you are on GALILEO, you can browse the databases by clicking on the [All Databases](#) button.

GALILEO access outside of the library requires a one-word password that is updated every 6 months. Call any of our library locations to acquire the most current password.

This includes resources such as:



- Your library card grants you access to free eBooks and eAudiobooks through the library with Overdrive using the Libby App!
- Items check out for 3 weeks at a time and will return themselves when they are due. There are no late fees or charges.
- If you find items that are currently checked out, you can place them on hold and you will be notified when they become available for you to download.



- **eRead Kids** is provided by the Georgia Public Library Service and is a large collection of free eBooks and eAudiobooks. This service has a selection of both fiction and non-fiction titles that can be downloaded to your device.
- To access eRead Kids, go to pinemountain.axis360.baker-taylor.com and login with your library card number and your PIN.
