I. OPENING BUSINESS

- A. Rosey Anderson, Chair, called the meeting to order. SGM Abraham Sexton, Clerk, delivered the Reflection.

 Dr. Rhett Richardson, member, led the pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Superintendent Stapleton announced that local media had received notice of the meeting as required by the Freedom of Information Act.
- B. The board unanimously approved the agenda. Motion was made by Dr. Rhett Richardson and seconded by SGM Abraham Sexton.
- C. Rosey Anderson performed the swearing in of newly elected board member, SGM Abraham Sexton.
- D. Election of Board Members by Chairperson
- E. The Board unanimously approved the Consent Agenda. Motion was made by Felicia Devore and seconded by SGM Abraham Sexton.

II. ACCOUNTABILITY

A. Recognition

- Superintendent Stapleton introduced Franklin McCormack, BHS Principal for recognition of the Barnwell
 High School Sporting Clays Team and accomplishments. Coach Sturkie and Coach Martin spoke as well as
 Senior Sporting Clays team members.
 - A. Dr. Rhett Richardson expressed being a board member and the initial apprehension and uneasiness of a sporting clay team, but he is proud of the board for allowing it to happen and very appreciative for everyone's hard work.
 - B. Becky Huggins expressed being very proud of the team and looks forward to seeing them in action. There are life lessons in hard work and dedication.
 - C. SGM Abraham Sexton stated that the team had to learn a lot of safety and responsibility. He was hesitant at first, but he came to the conclusion that team deserved a chance. He expressed being very proud of each member and how they have represented the school well.

B. Information

1. District Updates

- Superintendent Stapleton presented a follow-up on capital improvement updates which included the installation of the baseball bleachers at the end of March. The newest project is the installation of new bleachers in the BHS gymnasium.
- 2. Update on step increase is the finance department is in the process of determining the lump sum that will be paid to employees by June 15th for the step that had previously been frozen. The CFO is including the 20-21 step that was just reinstated and the step for the 21-22 in the new budget.

- 3. The Barnwell County Recreation Commission met to review drawings of the proposed YMCA swimming pool. Superintendent Stapleton shared that if the YMCA had a community pool, Barnwell School District 45 would love to have the opportunity for our students to participate in swim teams.
- 4. The allocation of ESSER II Funding is \$3,769,295. The funds will be used for facility upgrades related to student health, such as window and door replacements, HVAC replacements, and roof repairs. Also, academic recovery efforts would include 2 BPS Interventionists and summer programs at BPS, BES, and GBMS.
- 5. Graduation will be June 4, 2021 at W.W. Carter Field at 7:30pm. The high school is working to maximize the number of tickets we can provide each member of the senior class. Other events will be Baccalaureate at W.W. Carter Field on May 23, 2021 at 7:30 pm and Senior Awards Night at W.W. Carter Field on May 25, 2021 at 6:00 pm.
- 6. The 2021 STEM signing day celebrates high school seniors from across the country who choose to pursue STEM education at technical programs, two-and-four-year colleges. BHS students, James "Latham" Boone and MaKayla Smoak, were Barnwell County's recipients.
- 7. Barnwell School District 45 Teachers of the Year are: Aerial Baxley-BPS, Jenny Raines-BES, Heather Peters-GBMS, and Betsy Antley-BHS. Congratulations to our Teachers of the Year!

- A. Rosey Anderson motioned for the approval of the Bond Resolution. Superintendent Stapleton: the district would adopt a do not exceed amount. The not to exceed amount will be \$1,250,000.00 This is the same bond issue that we have discussed each year to make various repairs to the buildings. The board adopts a not to exceed amount. The final amount will be determined by the available 8% capacity and by the consultation with the County Auditor and Treasurer to obtain the balance in the debt service sinking fund account from 19-20 tax collections, as well as the assessed value of the district. Payments are made, and we maintain the current debt service millage unless there is a need to increase millage to maintain the debt payment. Motion: I make a motion to adopt a resolution authorizing the issuance and sale of a not to exceed \$1,250,000.00 general obligation bond. All were in favor and passed it unanimously. The motion was made by Felicia Devore and seconded by SGM Abraham Sexton.
- B. Rosey Anderson motioned for the approval of the modification to the substitute pay scale. Superintendent Stapleton: as a reminder about the substitute pay scale that we discussed in March, the recommendation for the work session was to eliminate the years of experience and pay a flat rate (like others we looked at). We also discussed the following rate changes. High School/Associate's degree changes to \$70 per day. Bachelor's degree changes to \$75 per day. These changes positively impact any sub we have on the list with little impact to the overall budget. Motion: I recommend we approve the changes to the substitute pay scale effective for the 2021-2022 school year and future years. High School/Associate's degree will change o \$70 per day. Bachelor's degree will change to \$75 per day. The motion was made by Becky Huggins and seconded by SGM Abraham Sexton.
- C. Dr. Rachel Wall discussed Title I and Title II updates and approvals. Rosey Anderson asked for a motion for the approval of the Title I and Title II updates and approvals. The motion was made by SGM Abraham Sexton and seconded by Felicia Devore.
