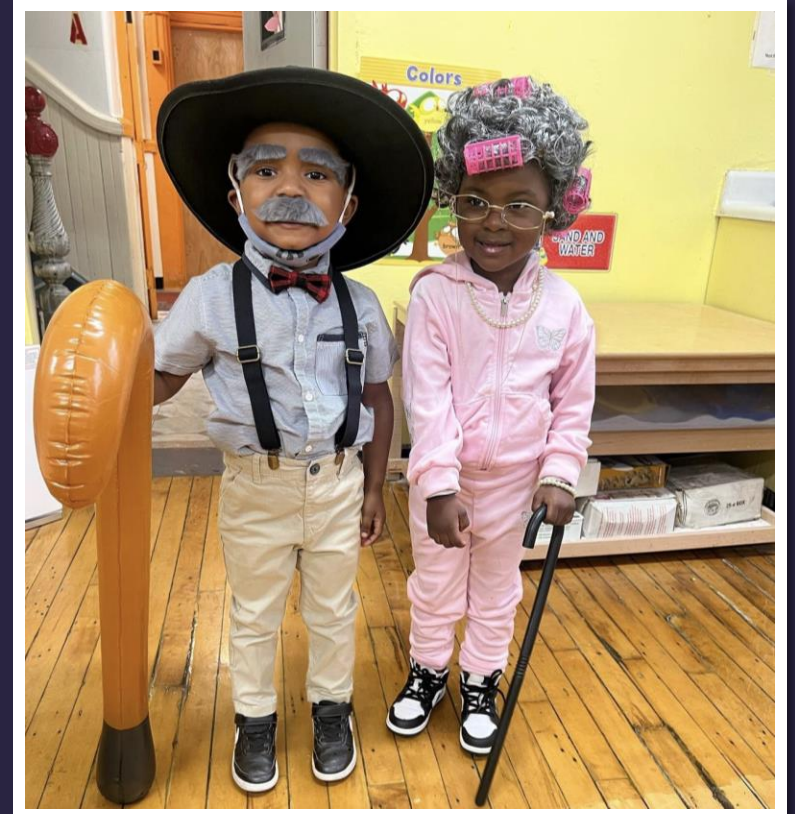

- ❑ Mastery Season – We are focusing on disaggregated iReady assessment data to promote explicit instruction of the skills needed to achieve standards mastery.
- ❑ Literacy Collaborative – 2 new middle schools (K518/K668) & 2 new elementary schools (K150/K298) to participate in the dyslexia screening pilot
- ❑ AIM Institute - Phase 1 (District Leaders & Principals)
 - Phase 2 (Early Adopters) &
 - Phase 3 (Half of Staff) are all actively engaged in reading research aligned to reading activity practice
- ❑ Accelerating Mathematics Learning – D23 is receiving additional mathematics support from the Division of Curriculum & Instruction (DCI) via a five-part professional learning series for Math Points from each school.

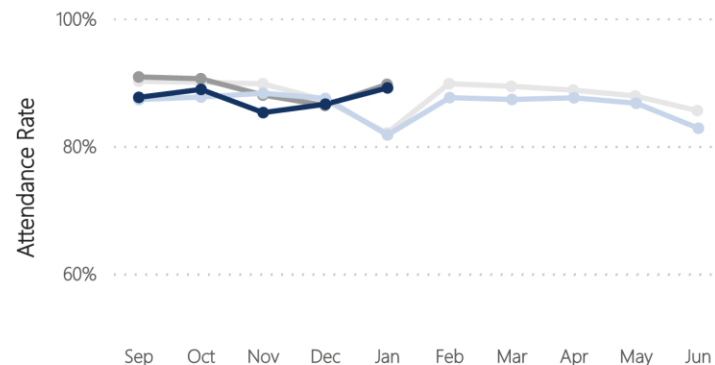

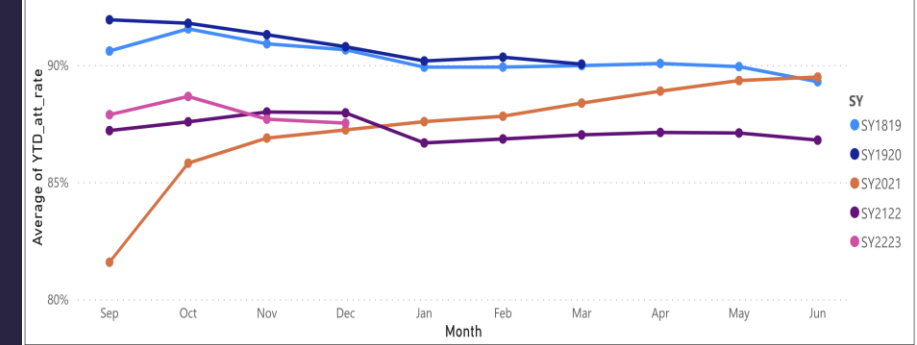

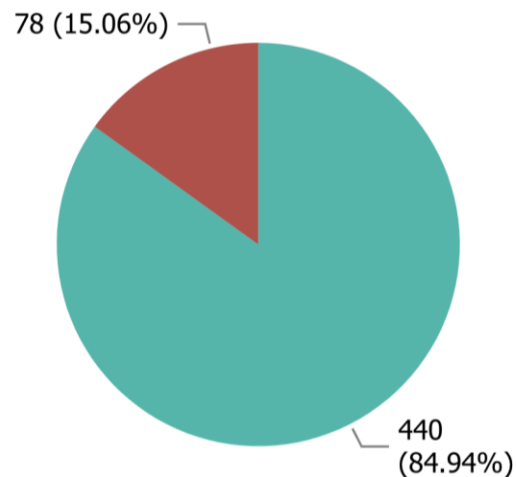

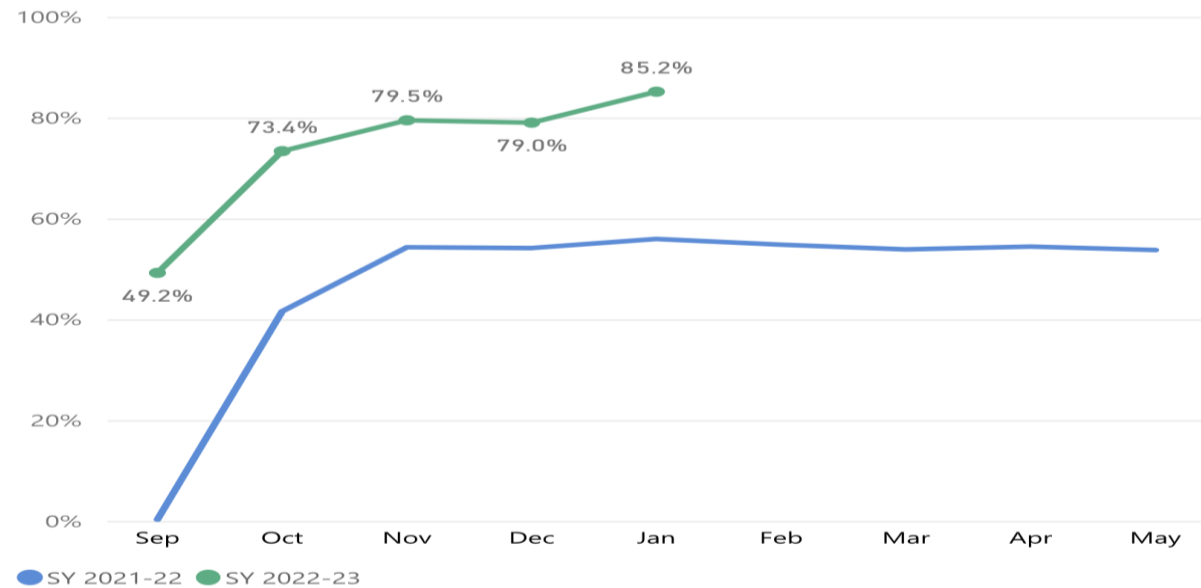

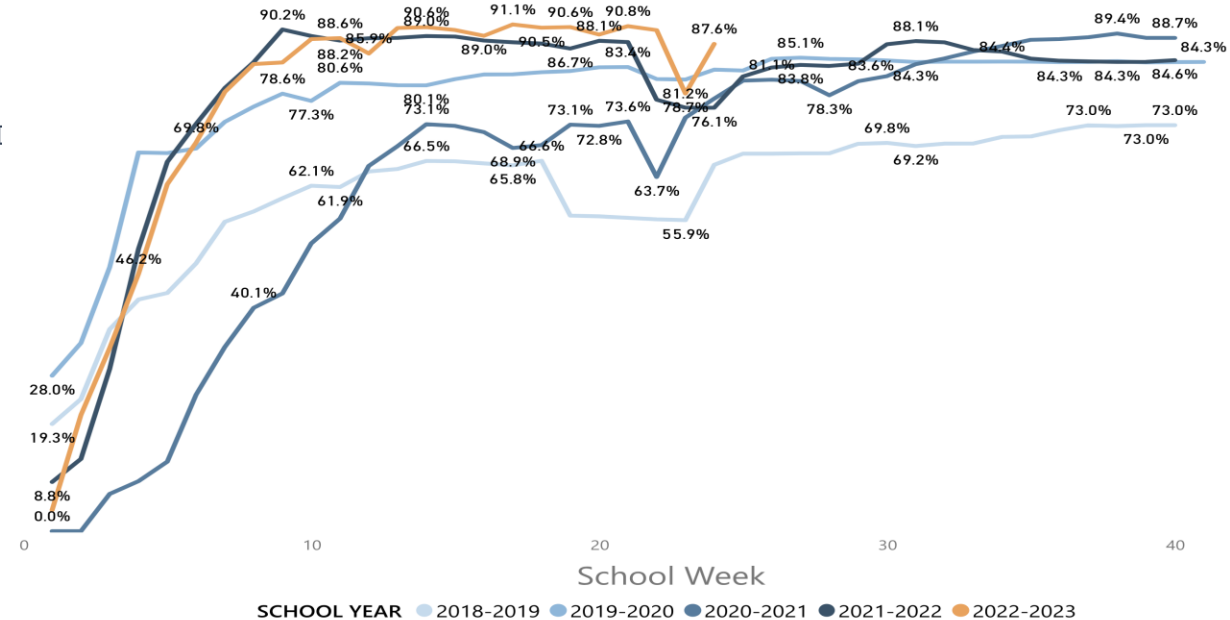

The Proposed Opening and Co-location of P077K@K150, a New Site of Existing District 75 School, P.S. K077 (75K077), with P.S. 150 Christopher (23K150) in Building K150 Beginning in the 2023-2024 School Year

A Joint Public Hearing will be held to provide the public with an opportunity to learn more about the above-referenced proposal and to present comments or concerns on the proposal. The date, time, and location of the hearing are as follows:

Date: Wednesday, March 8, 2023

Time: 6 p.m.

This Joint Public Hearing will be an opportunity to learn more about potential changes to building K150 and share feedback.

The New York City Department of Education (NYCDOE) is proposing to open and co-locate a new elementary school site of the existing District 75 school, P.S. K077 (75K077), to be called P077K@K150, in building K150 beginning in the 2023-2024 school year. K150 is located at 364 Sackman Street, Brooklyn, NY 11212, in Community School District 23, referred to as District 23. K150 also houses the community-based organization (CBO) St. Nick's Alliance.

Currently, K150 also houses Uncommon Brownsville Collegiate Charter School (84K710), referred to as Brownsville Collegiate, a charter middle school that is serving students in grades 6-8. Uncommon Brownsville Collegiate Charter School will no longer serve students in K150 after the conclusion of the 2022-2023 school year.

P.S. K077 is an existing multi-site District 75 school serving students in grades K-12 across four different locations in Brooklyn. If this proposal is approved, P077K@K150 will open in K150 where it will be co-located with P.S. 150 Christopher (23K150), referred to as P.S. 150, an existing district elementary school serving students in grades K-5 and in 3-K and pre-Kindergarten (pre-K) programs.

A co-location means that two or more school organizations are located in the same building and may share common spaces, such as auditoriums, gymnasiums, libraries, and cafeterias.

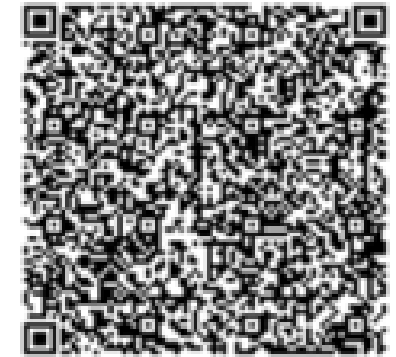
