Welcome to 4<sup>th</sup> Grade! We are excited to start this school year off! We look forward to all of the hard work from all of our students.

Your child will be taking the NYS Math, ELA, and Science tests this spring. With your support and guidance, we will be preparing your child with all the necessary test-taking skills they need for these exams.
