

Governing Board Norms

- 1. Consider the welfare of the students.
- 2. Assume best intentions.
- 3. Understand each other's role.
- 4. Make decisions professionally, not emotionally.
- 5. Keep lines of communication open and flowing.
- 6. Refer all complaints to the Dispute Resolution Policy.
- 7. Support policies or decisions once established.
- 8. Respect all people and ideas.
- 9. Use caution when speaking with the public. Remember to speak only for yourself, not for CMP or the Board.
- 10. Be an advocate for school programs and philosophies.
- 11. Establish priorities and remain focused.
- 12. Address all incidents of concern to the Principal or Executive Director.
- 13. Commit to developing understanding and trust.
- 14. Before voting, check all information with appropriate source to establish accurate facts.
- 15. Come prepared to all meetings by reading the documentation beforehand and informing the Governing Board Secretary if you will not be able to attend a meeting.
- 16. It is expected that Board Members attend every meeting.
