



## **Arrival**



Students being driven to school: drop-off is in the driveway between 9:05-9:15 am.

Walkers should arrive at school by 9:15 am. (Walkers are students who are not assigned to a bus and live within 1 mile from school.)

Kindergarten students will be met at their bus or car and escorted to their teacher/line-up and will *gradually*, and with *support*, make their own way to class.

# Kindergarten Screening

- Screening takes place at school in May.
- Child are escorted to a designated area and rotate through stations.
- Parent/Caregiver remain in the building to complete a questionnaire and take a guided tour.

# Kindergarten Visitation

Wednesday, August 28 at 10:00-11:00am

Kindergarten families join us at KES to meet the teachers and visit the classrooms for a Scavenger Hunt.

**Bus Tags will be distributed.** For those of you who are unable to attend the Kindergarten Visitation, you may pick-up your child's Bus Tag in the KES Main Office before school begins.

Students will have the opportunity to spend time in the classroom for centers and a read aloud while parents/caretakers meet with the administration for an orientation.


Families are invited to stay afterwards for a *Playground Playdate* hosted by the PTO.
