

<u>Reading</u>: Your child will be able to retell stories by understanding and identifying the story structure and sequence of events. Your child will compare and contrast characters by identifying differences and similarities in their traits, actions, and feelings.

Writing: Your child will continue to the develop their persuasive writing essay topics. They will also compare and contrast examples of essays to identify which one had the elements needed to persuade the reader.

Math: Your child will be able to understand fractions as equal parts of a whole by exploring equal shares, unit fractions, fractions of a whole and of a group and identify fractions on a number line.

Science: Your child will begin their investigation of Inheritance and Traits by exploring similarities and differences between organisms and species.

Social Studies: Your child will continue to explore the continent of Africa with particular focus on the country of Nigeria. They will investigate the country's landforms, history, economy, people, and their culture.
