

## **Community Education Council 23 Goals:**

### **1. Create a Collaborative Community Environment through Family Advocacy:**

The CEC of District 23 will provide collaborative groups for parents for the purpose of troubleshooting and supporting their needs. By the end of June 2021, we will provide parents with at least 8 monthly workshops. The workshops will focus on community needs for all parents, with an emphasis on families in Temporary Housing and families that are experiencing financial insecurity.

### **2. Provide Technology Support for Parent Leaders:**

The CEC of District 23 will provide opportunities for Parent Leaders to engage in workshops that support their technology needs. By the end of June 2021, the CEC will provide Parent Leaders and community parents with workshops designed to develop their use of Microsoft software, making flyers, and email development.

### **3. CEC Forums:**

The CEC will engage in public monthly meetings for the District 23 community and beyond. By the end of June 2021, the CEC will host public meetings for the purpose of engaging the community and parents at large to inform parents of school issues and community issues that impact schools. Parents will also be able to voice their suggestions and concerns at these meetings.

### **4. Shared Community Outreach:**

The CEC will provide opportunities for community outreach organizations to engage with parents and the community at large. By the end of June 2021, each CEC meeting will have at least 2 community-based organizations per month contribute resources to the families and community at large. Parents and the community at large will be exposed to organizations that provide support for various community issues and needs such as: domestic violence, breast cancer awareness, and Mothers and Mentors.

### **5. Support for Schools, SLT, PA/PTAs and President Councils:**

The CEC will provide ongoing support for schools and its SLTs, PA/PTAs and Presidents Council. The CEC will virtually visit schools, provide resources and engage in shared exchanges of information for the purpose of family advocacy and student achievement. By the end of June 2021, the CEC will compile a school list of information and the CEC will visit each of the 23 schools at least once a month.
