ELA, Math, Science, Social Studies & Spanish

Homework: 15 % (a minimum of 15 assignments per quarter; a minimum of 5 graded for mastery)

Classwork Rubric: 15 % (graded quarterly, ongoing documented data collection throughout the quarter)

Graded Classwork: 10 % (a minimum of 3 tasks per quarter)

Tests/Quizzes/Projects/Performance Tasks: 60 % (no one assessment to carry weight of more than 20%; criteria/rubric with clear explanation of grades must be evident as applicable)

G.S.*, Computer & Health

Homework: 10 % (a minimum of 5 assignments, a maximum of 10 per quarter; a minimum of half graded for mastery)

Classwork Rubric: 20 % (graded quarterly, ongoing documented data collection throughout the quarter)

Graded Classwork: 20 % (a minimum of 3 tasks per quarter)

Graded Tasks: 50 % (no one assessment to carry weight of more than 20%; criteria/rubric with clear explanation of grades must be evident as applicable)

Physical Education*

Grades are based on classwork rubric as follows:

Participation in whole class discussions/activities: 20% Participation in small group/pair discussions/activities: 20%

Completion of independent tasks: 20%

Preparedness: 20%

Commitment to Learning: 20%

Acceptable Grades: 55, 60, 65 and single point grades from 66 to 100. Grades of 60 are not permissible in MP5. Grades of 65 and above are considered passing.

*Students must attend G.S. or Physical Education 3 times per week to receive a numerical grade. Students that attend 1 or 2 times per week will receive a P ("pass")/F ("fail") grade. (Grades 65 and above constitute a P.)
