Reading and Writing

Science

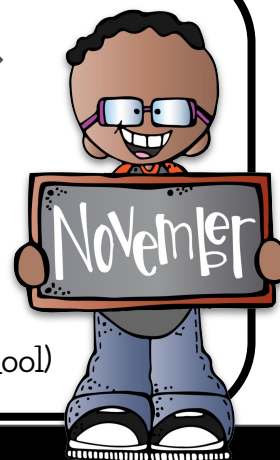
Children will continue the Animal and Plant Defenses unit. This unit presents an opportunity for students to delve deeply into understanding the structures that make up animals and plants, as well as how some of these structures can function as defenses against predators. They will also learn about what animals need to survive and grow.

Math

Children will continue to learn and practice strategies for finding sums such as counting on, making ten, and making doubles. They will begin to learn to use different strategies to solve subtraction facts to 20 such as Make 10 to Subtract. The strategies in this topic will also help your child solve word problems.
