## Digital student return of school items

Books - Books should have a post-it note with the student name and teacher written on it. Mrs. Beck will direct parents/students where to place these books in the snack shop area.

8th-grade chromebooks - 8th-grade students are returning their chromebooks. Chromebooks and powercords can be delivered to Mrs. Bondra in the library. Students and/or parents must check-in with Mrs. Bondra for this process. Chromebooks should not be left out in the foyer or snack shop area. If the student is taking a summer course at the high school, he or she should keep his or her chromebook. Students will be given new chromebooks as Freshmen in August at the high school.

Locker clean out - the building will be open from 3 to 7 pm, today, Thursday, and Friday. Parents can bring students to "clean out" their lockers during this time.
