Náshdóítsoh Dress Code

This dress code is designed around two ideals:

- 1- A safe environment for students- if gang affiliation is being displayed the clothing will be asked to be changed or removed (REGRADLESS OF THE CLOTHING BEING IN THIS CODE OR NOT)
- 2- Displaying respect for the school and its academic environment. This is a learning institution, learning comes first.

General rules: **no blue (any shade of blue) or red colored clothing will be allowed** (EXCEPT FOR BLUE JEAN DENIM). All clothing will be clean and presentable. No skin will be visible between the bottom of the shirt and the pant beltline while wearing a shirt when the hands are raised above the head. Clothing will not be over sized or undersized for the student's measurements. Low cut clothing that shows cleavage or an inappropriate amount of skin is not allowed.

Individual classes may dictate more specific dress codes for their periods of instruction that are created for the health and safety of the student (example PE Class- these will be communicated to parents and students by separate communication and only apply to that class).

ALL Tops must be one of the following colors: WHITE, YELLOW, GOLD, MAROON, GRAY, PEACH, PINK, TEAL, TURQUOISE, BROWN, ORANGE, RUST.			
TOPS	Male	Female	
Polos	Any polo, Stripes OK. Logos less than the total size of a quarter embroidered on the polos are permissible		
Collared shirts	Plaid shirts and dress shirts are allowed.	Plaid shirts and dress shirts are allowed. Blouses are allowed. No strapless blouses, blouses without two straps, or straps that are less than two inches wide at the shoulder.	
Undershirts	Allowed, solid colors (see general rules for exceptions) only. Only worn under a polo or other appropriate shirt.		
T-Shirts	THS spirit shirts approved by the administration can be worn anyday Plain short or long sleeved T- shirts in these two solid colors only: Maroon or Gold		
Sweatshirts/Jackets	Only to be worn when classrooms are cooler than 65 degrees. Hoods are not to be worn.		
Hats	No bandannas. No caps or hats worn inside buildings. No beanies, stocking caps, or watch caps.		
Piercings	Visible piercings are limited to the ears. If students have piercings on other visible places they must have a permission note from their parent of record on file in order to wear the piercing in school.		
Sunglasses	Sunglasses are not allowed in the classroom

Shoes	Not allowed: high heels with 3 or more inches of wedge; flip flops/shower shoes. Shoes must be worn safely for the wearer and those around them.	
Dresses		Must meet all of the requirements for collared shirts and skirts.
Belts	Belts will be secured around waist with not more than 6 inches of material showing past the buckle. No hanging chains from the belt.
