

# 43rd Annual Live Bethlehem Christmas Pageant

Dear Friends of Live Bethlehem Christmas Pageant,

Plans for the 2022 LIVE BETHLEHEM CHRISTMAS PAGEANT are under way. This will be the 43rd annual presentation for the community. It will be performed at the Bethlehem Rose Garden Band Shell on 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue in West Bethlehem in Bethlehem, PA, on Saturday, December 10<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, December 11<sup>th</sup> at 1:45 p.m. on both days.

The Pageant is a fully costumed re-enactment of the historical events surrounding the birth of Christ. Joseph accompanies the Virgin Mary, who is with a donkey to the stable where Christ is born and laid in a manger. The Angels appear and summon the shepherds who come with their offerings of sheep and various other animals. The Wise Men and camels, with an escort of Soldiers on horseback, arrive to receive the words of Herod and the High Priests. They proceed to the stable where the Holy Family and the resident animals await under the watchful care of the Angels. Singers and a narrator tell the beautiful story as the Pageant unfolds.

There is a musical Prelude at 1:45 p.m. The Pageant is approximately one hour. NO TICKETS are required nor is there admission charge; however, a goodwill offering is requested. Since it is outdoors, we suggest you dress very warmly with boots, caps and gloves, and bring blankets. Limited seating is available. The Pageant is presented regardless of the weather conditions.

PARKING: Some parking is available on surrounding streets, but check signs and make certain the space is legal! Later take an opportunity to stroll through Historic Downtown Bethlehem to see the many lovely shops and restaurants. Several Museums are close by and are featuring Christmas exhibits.

We depend on the generosity of the members of our Community, who believe we should continue the Pageant as one of Bethlehem's traditions. To help meet our necessary expenses, please return the bottom portion of the other side of this letter with your donation. Contributions received by November 27th will be recognized in the program for this year. Later contributions will be listed in next year's program.
